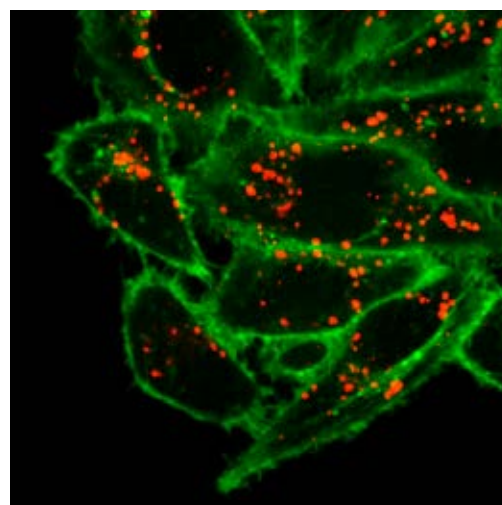
A BIOCHEMICAL SOCIETY SCIENTIFIC MEETING
