

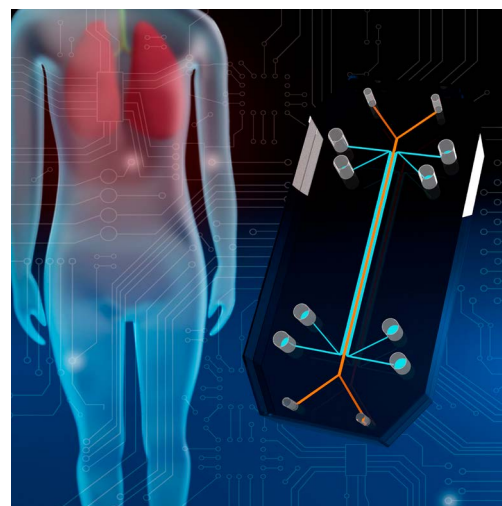

Organ-on-a-Chip is a hot topic and one of keen interest to many scientists working in translational sciences.
