Journals move to a hybrid model where authors can choose OA

2009

*Bioscience Reports* journal 'flips' to full OA supported by APCs

2012

Portland Press opts for a sustainable transition to OA across all journals

2017

Open Science position statement published

2018

50% of journal articles published in 2018 are OA

Transformative *Read & Publish* pilots launched to support unlimited OA publishing on an APC-free basis

2019

Open Scholarship position statement published

2020

9% of total content is published OA without APCs under transformative routes\*

New data policy implemented

## WE ARE TRANSITIONING

- We have launched our *Read & Publish* offering supporting unlimited and uncapped open access publishing
- Corresponding authors can publish unlimited open access with no article publishing charges
- Over 200 institutions globally are benefiting in 2021 from our *Read & Publish* offering and are supporting their scholars in publishing open access in our journals and bringing them read access



## HOW DID *READ & PUBLISH* IMPACT OPEN ACCESS OUTPUTS DURING 2020?

- **10%** of subscription income has been from *Read & Publish* agreements
- **10%** of content published open access has been via a *Read & Publish* route
